School Golf


<u>Design Brief.</u>



You will also be required to manufacture all **relevant details** such as bunkers, the rough, ramps, bridges, lakes and any other features relating to those individual themes.

Each teams can come up with their own them or choice one from the list below. No two teams can cover the same theme.




