Room Layout

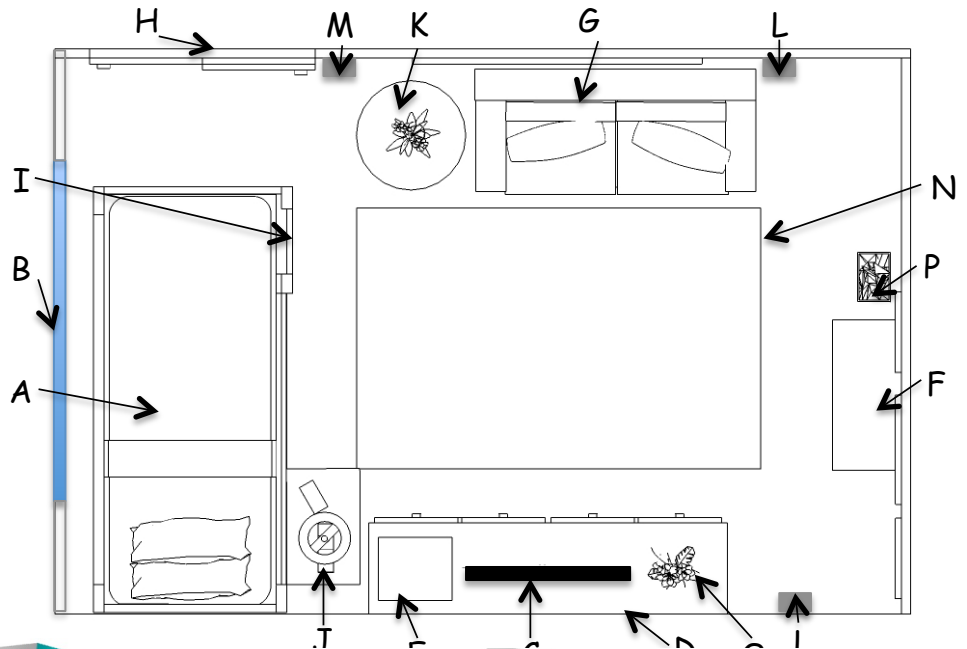
CONTEXT

Below is a birds eye view of a typical everyday bedroom, if you look carefully it is possible to make out the shape of all the different items from the bed right down to the light switch and sockets on the walls. A more technical term for birds eye view is a **PLAN VIEW**.

When designing it is important to draw out what we are going to do or make to ensure that things look right, are to the correct scale and actually fit in place.

- A Bed
- B Window
- C TV
- D Cupboard
- E Games Console
- F Book Shelf
- G Chair
- H Door
- I Bed Ladder
- J lamp
- K Side Table
- L Electrical sockets
- M Light Switch
- N Rug
- O Plant
- P Bin



DESIGN TASK

Take a piece of A4 paper or use the grid.

Choose a room in your house and draw a plan view of it remembering to think about the shape of the room and the scale of the objects within it.

You must show where the doors and windows are, and where the light switches and sockets are.
